Your assignment:

- Select a theme around one of the principles that you adhere to.
- Write a thesis statement in critical voice. Set it up on a title page.
- Select 10-15 pictures that say something about the theme. You can take your own pictures if you wish.
- Try to achieve unity of purpose and style
- Add a caption or an explanatory sentence to each picture.
- Find a poem that expresses the same theme. Do not choose the pictures to tell the plot of the poem. This essay is not to tell the plot of the poem.
- Put it all together in a PowerPoint presentation, or on a bristol board
- Last slide: -bibliographic entry for the poem and the pictures. If you have taken the pictures yourself, credit yourself. (bibme.org).
