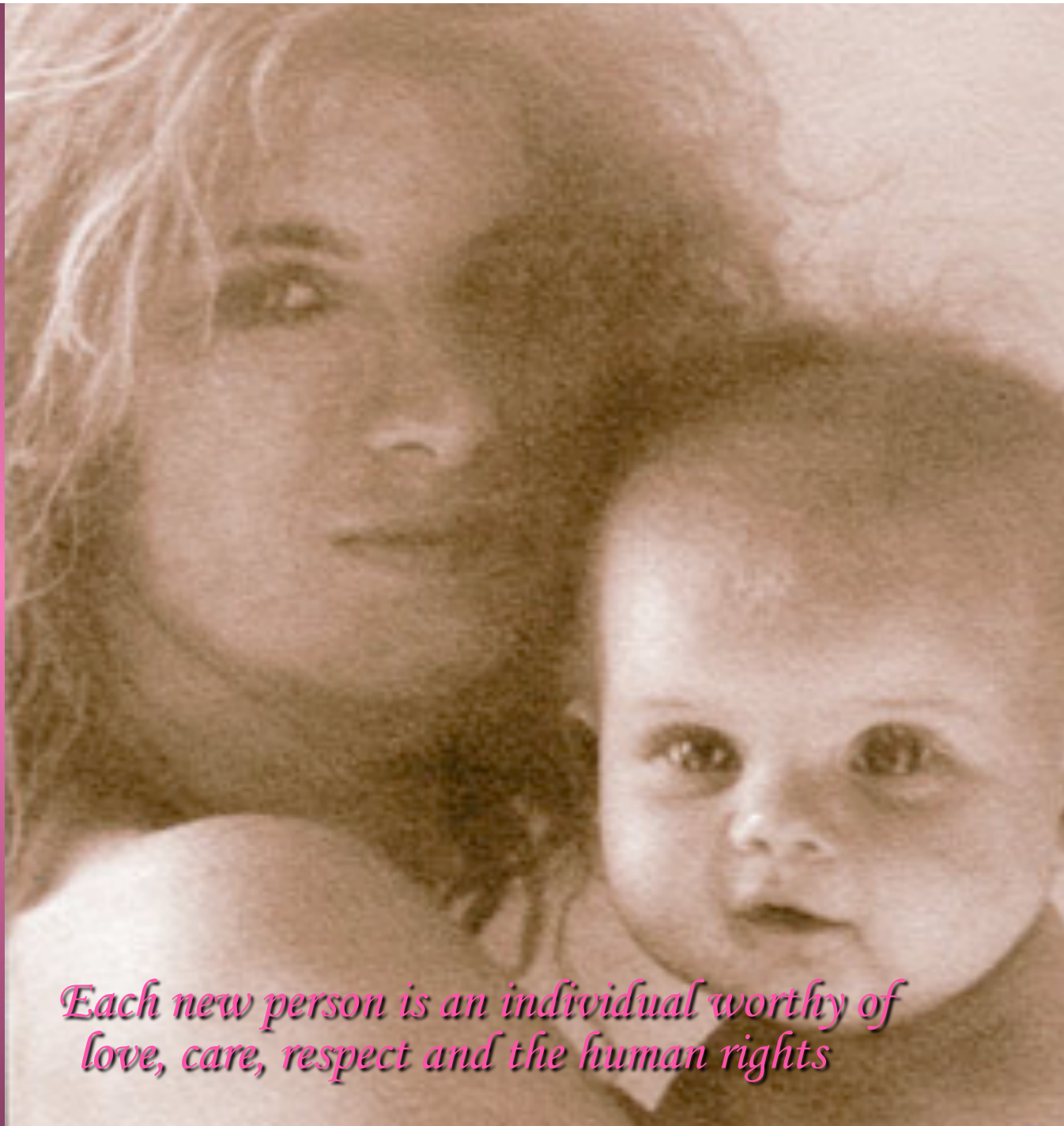


Respect for Human Life
